You could be:

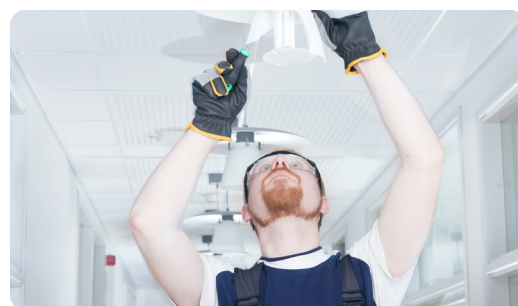
- a teaching assistant
